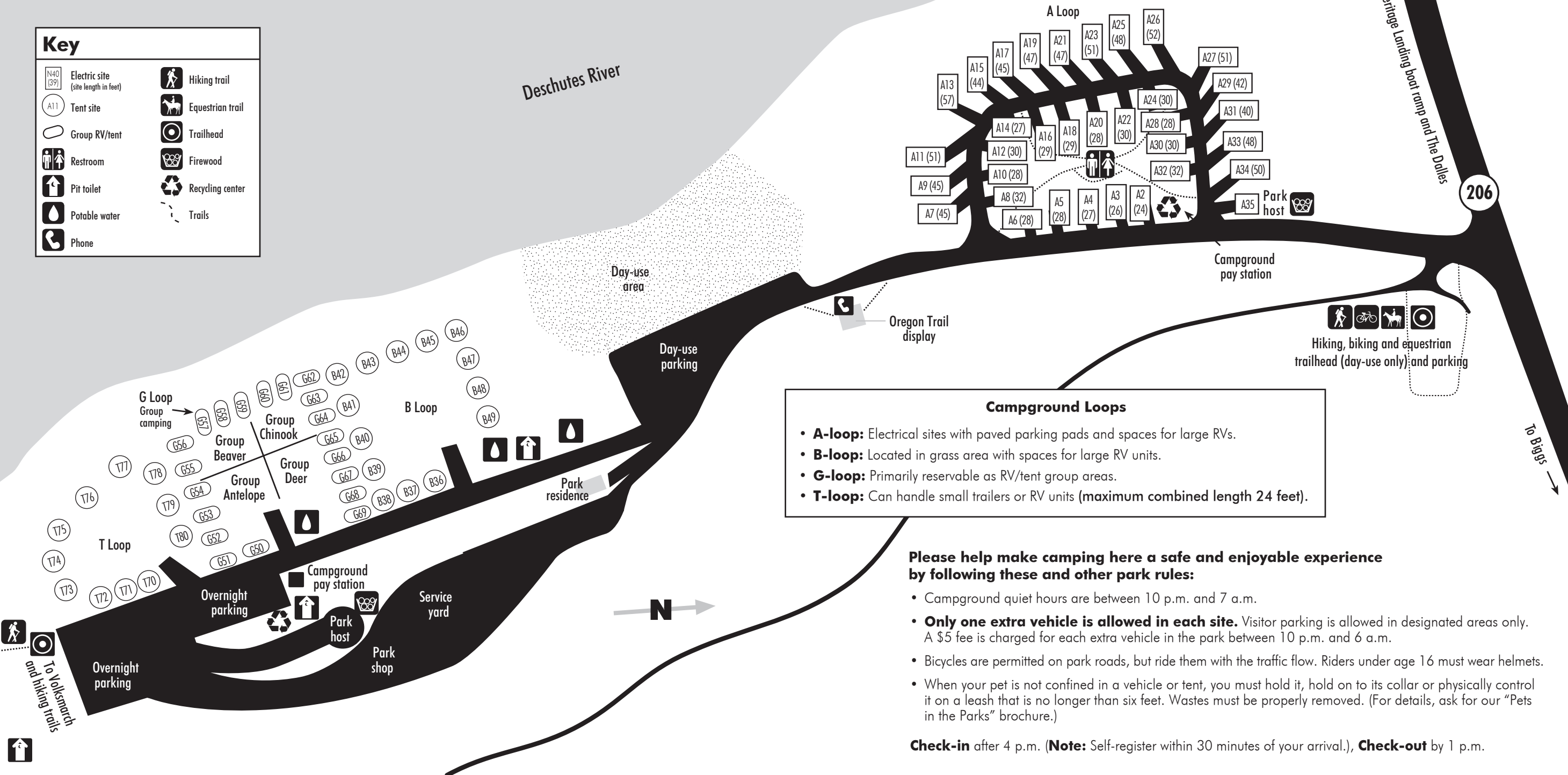


# Deschutes River State Recreation Area

### Campground Loops

- **A-loop:** Electrical sites with paved parking pads and spaces for large RVs.
- **B-loop:** Located in grass area with spaces for large RV units.
- **G-loop:** Primarily reservable as RV/tent group areas.
- **T-loop:** Can handle small trailers or RV units (maximum combined length 24 feet).

**Please help make camping here a safe and enjoyable experience by following these and other park rules:**

- Campground quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- **Only one extra vehicle is allowed in each site.** Visitor parking is allowed in designated areas only. A \$5 fee is charged for each extra vehicle in the park between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Bicycles are permitted on park roads, but ride them with the traffic flow. Riders under age 16 must wear helmets.
- When your pet is not confined in a vehicle or tent, you must hold it, hold on to its collar or physically control it on a leash that is no longer than six feet. Wastes must be properly removed. (For details, ask for our "Pets in the Parks" brochure.)

**Check-in** after 4 p.m. (**Note:** Self-register within 30 minutes of your arrival.), **Check-out** by 1 p.m.
