Mayfield Lake Park's group camp area has 12 sites, a kitchen shelter and its own bathroom—making it perfect for family reunions and other large get-togethers. Three of the sites have water and electric hookups. The group camp is separated from the other camping areas, which gives campers a sense of privacy.

Go jump in a lake

Love the water? Then you'll love Mayfield Lake. Spend your days swimming, boating, water skiing or fishing for trout, bass and coho salmon. The easy-to-use boat launch makes boating a breeze. Mayfield Lake is a popular destination for water sport enthusiasts, so we ask that you play it safe and learn the boating and watercraft rules before you dive into the fun.

Hatch a plan to discover the area

Looking for adventure? Visit the overlooks at nearby Mayfield and Mossyrock dams, or explore the nearby Cowlitz salmon and trout hatcheries.

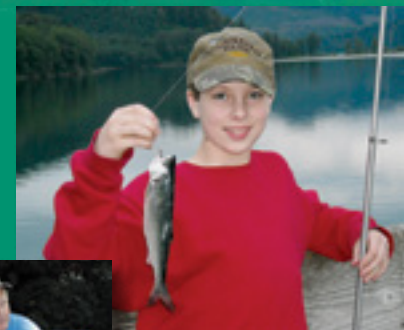

About... Mayfield Lake Park

- Year-round day-use area and boat launch (Open during daylight hours)
- Campsites open between April 15 and October 15
- 55 individual campsites with water and electric hookups
- 12-unit group camp area open between Memorial Day weekend and October 15
- Fire rings or barbecue grills and picnic tables in all campsites
- Coin-operated showers
- Wheelchair-accessible sites and restroom
- Reservable kitchen shelter

Camping fees

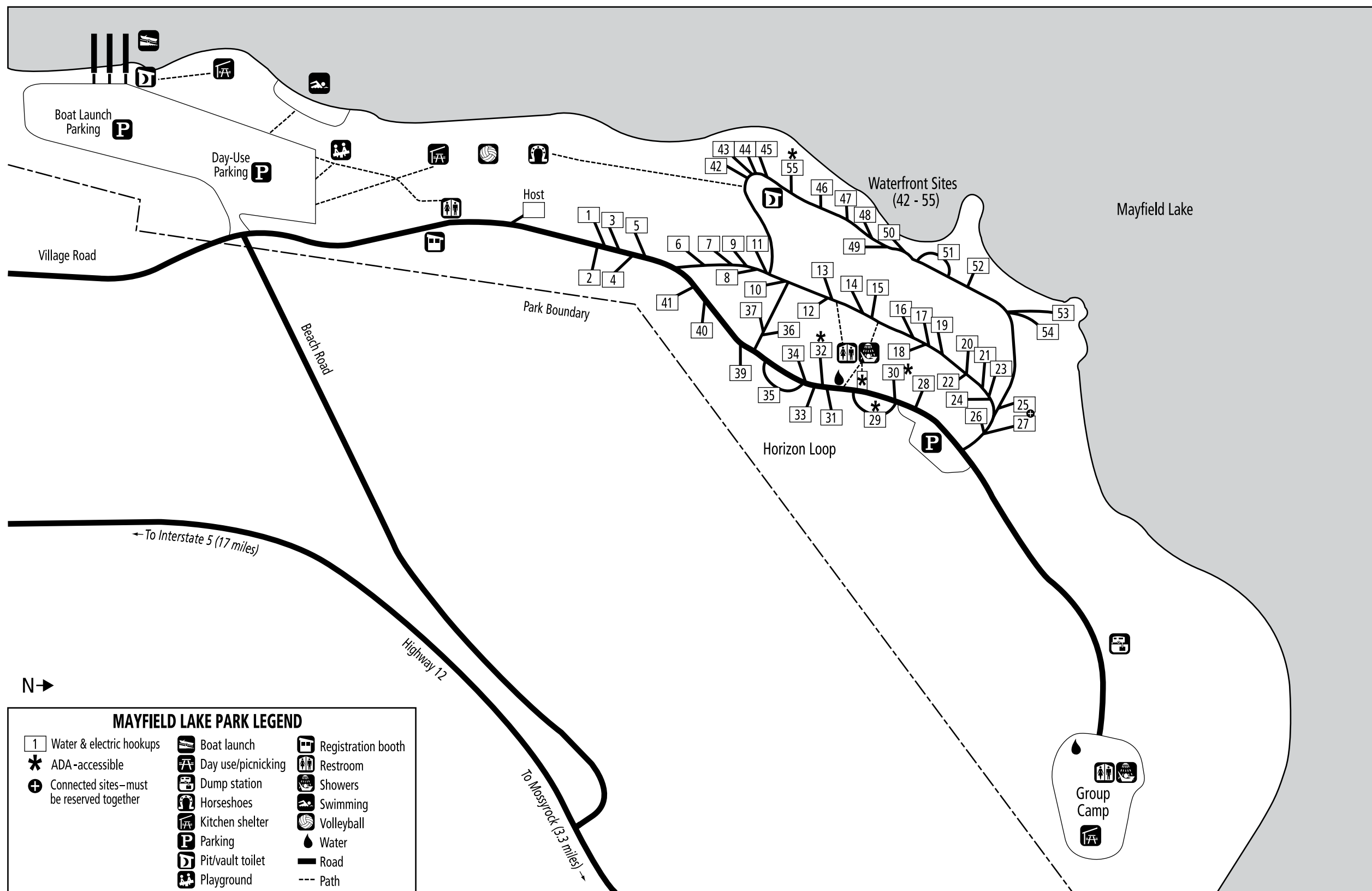
- \$31 Water and electric hookups
- \$35 Waterfront, water and electric hookups (Sites 42-55)
- \$200 Group camp (Entire area – 12 sites)
- \$10 Extra vehicle (No charge for towed vehicles)
- \$75 Extra vehicle season pass

- \$6.50 Online

- \$5 Day-use parking (Weekends and holidays between Memorial Day and Labor Day weekends)
