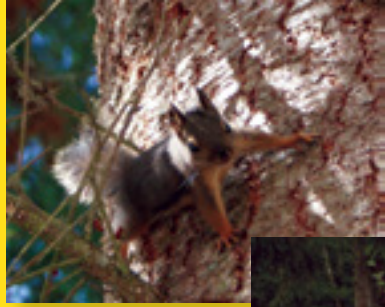

Rules, Reservations and Fees



Park rules To maximize enjoyment of our parks, we ask everyone to follow these simple rules.

With all due respect

Keep it down! People like to sleep, so quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. We don't allow amplified music.

You may want your buddy in the site next to you, but keep in mind the site must be paid for and occupied with a tent or RV to hold it.

You may be a kid at heart, but can't be a kid to rent a campsite. We only rent to people who are at least 18 years old.

We don't allow glass bottles in swimming beach areas.

Between May 15 and September 15, park stays are limited to 10 consecutive days. The rest of the year, you may stay a total of 10 days in a 30-day period.

Pitch your tent so it hits the spot

If a tent is allowed at your site, please set it up within the site's boundaries.

Be careful where you lift your spirits

Think small. Alcohol in kegs and other bulk containers is not allowed.

Store and consume alcoholic beverages only in your site or group camp circle.

Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the day-use areas or on the Taidnapam Park fishing bridge.

Park it here. Or there. But not just anywhere.

Your campsite fee includes only one vehicle. Additional or unattended vehicles, unless towed, cost \$10 each per night.

You may purchase an unattended vehicle permit to park overnight in the day-use parking area at Mossyrock Park.

Sorry, we don't allow overnight parking in the day-use and boat launch areas at Alder Lake, Mayfield Lake and Taidnapam parks. However, unattended vehicles may remain overnight at the North Taidnapam boat launch.

Leave your gas and electric pocket bikes at home. Only people with disabilities may operate ADA-approved mobility devices in the parks.

Please don't park or drive on vegetated areas.

Get fired up

We provide fire pits or fire rings for your safety and don't allow campfires anywhere else.

Using power saws is not allowed in the campgrounds.

You're not allowed to cut or burn live or downed trees. Each park may have additional rules about collecting branches and driftwood.

Animal instincts

Your pets are part of your family, but they can sometimes get in the way of other campers. These rules will help avoid some common pet peeves.

- Keep your pets under control in cages or on physical leashes no longer than eight feet. (Make sure someone is holding the other end of the leash.)
- At night, keep them in a tent or enclosed vehicle.
- Scoop the poop. We provide bags to make it easier for you.
- Keep pets off swimming beaches and the Taidnapam Park fishing bridge and out of restrooms and showers.

Please do not feed the wildlife.

Bringing livestock into the parks is not permitted.

Float your boat

Boat launches close at dusk.

Docks may not be used for skiing, swimming or diving.

Observe and follow state and local boating regulations.

It is illegal to operate watercraft in excess of 8 mph in Lewis County and 5 mph in Pierce County within 200 feet of any shore, dock, public swimming area or log boom.

Please observe no-wake zones.

Boat moorage at Alder Lake

Alder Lake Park offers free moorage on a first-come, first-served basis.

Moorage is limited to 10 consecutive days. The park does not allow overnight camping on moored boats or the saving of boat slips with personal items.

Cultural awareness

Natural and cultural resources are protected on our lands. Please leave all rocks, minerals and artifacts where you find them.

Report vandalism by talking with a park supervisor or by calling (253) 502-8824.

Play it safe

The discharge or unlawful display of firearms is not permitted in the parks. Fireworks are not allowed.

Please obey all posted speed limits.

Cancelling or reducing nights?

The longer you've held the reservation, the more it costs to cancel or reduce the number of nights in your stay.

The following fees will apply:

- Seven days or more before your scheduled arrival date, you'll be charged:
 - 5% to 50% of the cost of cancelled nights, and
 - \$8.50 online or \$10.50 when you call 1-888-226-7688
- Six days or fewer before your scheduled arrival date, you'll be charged:
 - 20% to 50% of the cost of cancelled nights, and
 - \$8.50 online or \$10.50 when you call 1-888-226-7688

Changing your reservation?

The following will apply for reservation changes:

- If you change your reservation without reducing the number of nights, you'll be charged \$8.50 online or \$10.50 at 1-888-226-7688.
- Extend your stay in the original site reserved without a change fee.
- If space allows, you may change sites at check-in without a change fee.

Let us know if you won't show

If we don't see or hear from you by 1 p.m. the day after you're scheduled to arrive, we will consider your reservation a no-show. Your site may be available to other campers. There are no refunds in no-show situations.

Booking group camps and kitchen shelters

- Alder Lake and Taidnapam parks: Mail in or drop off forms and deposits at the park after Jan. 1 for that year.
- Mayfield Lake and Mossyrock parks: Reserve at tacomapower.com/parks or call 1-888-226-7688.

Campsite costs

Alder Lake Park

- \$33 Water/electric/sewer hookups
- \$31 Water/electric hookups
- \$23 Tent sites

Mayfield Lake Park

- \$31 Water/electric hookups
- \$35 Waterfront, water/electric hookups (Sites 42-55)
- \$200 Group camp, 3 of 12 sites with hookups (Entire area - 12 sites)

Mossyrock Park

- \$31 Water/electric hookups
- \$24 No hookups
- \$18 Walk-in and S'mores Loop sites
- \$185 Primitive group camps (12 sites)
- \$100-125 Group camp pods (5 - 6 sites)

Taidnapam Park

- \$33 Water/electric/sewer hookups
- \$31 Water/electric hookups
- \$18 Walk-in sites
- \$185 Primitive group camp (Entire area - 12 sites)

Bringing more than one vehicle?

One vehicle is included in the camping fee. Additional or unattended vehicles, unless towed, cost \$10 each per night.

Eight is enough

We allow up to eight people to occupy each campsite.



Other money matters

Reservation fees

We charge an administration fee in addition to your campsite costs:

- \$6.50 online or \$8.50 at 1-888-CAMPOUT
- Group campsites - \$15 per group at Alder Lake and Taidnapam parks

Discounts

We offer \$5 per night discounts for campsite fees to people who:

- Are 62 years old or more
- Have a disability parking placard
- Have a Washington State Parks disability or disabled veteran pass

You must occupy the campsite and show proof of eligibility to receive the discount.

Refunds

If you paid with a:

- Credit card, we may ask for your card number to credit the same account.
- Check or money order, we will mail you a check from the City of Tacoma.

It's about time

When can you stay and play?

Individual sites are available for reservations between May 15 and September 15. Sites are open on a first-come, first-served basis the rest of the year.

Campground check-in begins at 2:30 p.m. Check out is at 1 p.m.

Day-use visitors may use the boat launch and picnic areas between 8 a.m. and dusk.

Parks are closed between December 20 and January 1.

Registration

Please register at the park when you arrive to secure your site, pay extra vehicle fees or show proof of discount.

Bring your confirmation letter to speed up the registration process.

If we've closed the gate for the day, please open the gate and close it after you have entered the park. You may register the next morning.
